

CUMMING COMMENTS ON JURY PROGRAM

Tuesday's broadcast was the last of a pair recorded here at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Jack Glass in the "Junior Jury" series. Many local listeners report tuning in on the feature, broadcast over CKRM.

Friday night, a brand-new company took over the assignment to bring new voices and new ideas to the weekly program. However, instead of making the recordings at Indian Head, the party travelled to Regina and made up the show in CKRM's studios.

Making the trip were junior jury members Doreen Huber, Scott Eichel, Lennie Warne and Janice Raymond. Senior jury members were Mrs. Cliffe Horsman, Les Jupp and Lyle Alexander.

This group again recorded two programs, of which the first will be heard next Tuesday, Feb. 12, and the second one week later, Feb. 19.

The weekly programs, which have aroused widespread interest, are broadcast each Tuesday at 7.30 over CKRM. They are sponsored by Indian Head's Home & School Club in co-operation with the Canadian Mental Health association.

Far from being "dry as dust" the program generally produces a rib-tickler or two.
